ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant’s Motion to Stay Proceedings Related to Plaintiffs’ Motion for Partial Summary Judgment or, in the Alternative, to Extend Time for Response (doc. 24). Having considered the Motion, the Court hereby **GRANTS in part and DENIES in part** the Motion. The Court **DENIES** the request to stay proceedings. However, the Court **GRANTS** the request for an extension of time as follows:

- Defendant’s deadline to file a response to Plaintiffs’ Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is *extended* to **ten days after** the Court rules on Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss or, in the Alternative, Transfer (doc. 10).
- Plaintiffs must file their reply in support of their Motion for Partial Summary Judgment **fifteen days** after Defendant files a response.
